Kick-off seminar of WEP, the Nordic- Arab Network of Research on Women's Empowerment, Gender and Politics:

Moving gender from the margin to the center of comparative politics. Understanding gendered processes of politics and power

Dates: November 1-3, 2010

Venue: Aalborg University, Denmark.

What are the role of women and feminist organization in democratization processes? What have been the determinants for best practices in securing the genders' equal rights? What influences the gendered patterns of migration and what are the risks and the potential for empowerment of migrating groups? How do we understand the different interpretations of men and women in the media? What is the role of religion and in which ways does it impede and facilitate gender equality? The first WEP seminar will address these issues in plenary presentations and papers presented during the workshop sessions. Analyses of the similarities and differences within the Arab and the Nordic region and between the regions are welcome.

The conference offers a unique opportunity for master students, PhD students and Postdoctoral scholars from the MENA region and the Nordic countries to present their work on women and politics in a broad sense including projects on women in politics, policy changes and gendered rights, migration and labour market, media and religion.

**Participants**: The workshop is *primarily* aimed at master students, PhD students and other young scholars taking and interest in and doing research on gender, politics in the Middle East and the Nordic Countries. However, some senior researchers are also welcome.
